FUNDRAISING

Fundraising total to date - \$5870

Tree Chipping/Bottle Drive

- \$1081.05 raised from bottle drive. \$908 raised from steel/tin/copper collected by Martin Robson and remitted to Mac's Traders.
- \$800 raised from tree chipping, minus \$155.00 for pizza for volunteers.
Total raised \$2634.05.

Basket of Spirits

- The raffle made a total of \$3307.15

Pub Night – (end of February/beginning of March)

- Roxanne contacted 5 pubs.
- Murrayville Pub charges \$17 for a burger meal. Tickets sell for \$25 each.
