Welcome & Introductions

Minutes: The minutes of the May 2023 meeting were adopted.

Principal's Report (J. Harris)

- Currently have 805 students
- New Staff this year: New Principal (Mr. Harris) & one new Vice Principal (Mrs. Koehler) were joined by (6 new teachers, new youth care worker, 5 new SEA's and a new Admin. Assistant this year. Mrs. Koehler was previously at RE Mountain for 3 years.
- Mr. Harris brings a unique perspective to Poppy as he is a former Poppy graduate himself.
- He stressed the importance of academics in conjunction with the other activities and courses that complete a student's high school experience (music, athletics, clubs, etc.). And noted that Poppy has a very dedicated staff to help make this happen.
- Poppy is a "Lighthearted Place with an Intense Mission"
- Spirit Week lots of students took part in the festivities around school, dressing up and enjoying the week.
- Terry Fox Run at the assembly staff shared their stories and journeys with a key message being hope.
- Upcoming Pro-D staff will be taking part in a Trauma Informed Workshop to better understand and support students who have experienced trauma.
- The Poppy website is in process of being updated, including a new ical calendar.
- Tutorial time 35 minute block after the first block of the day which is meant for students as study time, to get extra help in any classes they may need. Work is underway to rebuild the culture to have the students use the block appropriately and how to get the most out of it.
- Feeding Futures the Provincial government has granted funds to the district for food programs and there will be more information forthcoming about this at an upcoming meeting

Co-President's Report (K. Leifso & S. Young)

- We are looking to continue building connections with our feeder schools to build the Poppy community and hopefully, find future PAC members.
 - Mr. Harris noted that the admin of the Poppy Family of Schools meet regularly to organize sports tournaments, music etc. for the feeder schools to increase their engagement with Poppy
 - Comment from parent all feeder schools should be given equal access and opportunities, for example, Wix does not have the music program that was previously run by the Poppy music department any longer. Mr. Harris is going to investigate.
- We still require a DPAC rep
- Dry Grad, while not a PAC event, is still looking for a Chairperson to ensure that the event can happen for our students.
