## GRAD 12 TRANSCRIPTS

Counsellors met with Grade 12 students during tutorial on October 11<sup>th</sup> to help them sign up for the Student Transcript Service (STS). This service allows universities to access their grades and it is the only way to receive a student's official transcript. Schools cannot generate official transcripts, and it is only available through the Ministry of Education through the STS. It is the student's responsibility to sign up, and they can order transcripts now and in the future. Students can locate their PEN on any of their report cards or on MyEd. STS instructions are available on the DW Poppy website under the Counselling Centre tab, or on the Poppy Grad 2024 Teams. A handout is also attached. Thank you for helping our grade 12 students stay on top of their post-secondary plans.

## POST SECONDARY SCHOLARSHIPS

SASSY Langley for 2024 is up and running for its ninth year. In that time, \$100,000 has been awarded to Langley students headed for post-secondary education. Last year, 61 applications were received, of which 95% were from Grade 12 Langley School District students.

### SCHOOL CLOSURES DURING INCLEMENT WEATHER

The Langley School District uses a notification system called SchoolMessenger to communicate information to families. If you did not receive a text or email message during our most recent power outage, then please

Snow closures and power outages are an annual occurrence in Langley School District. So, where do you go to get information about the status of schools during periods of inclement weather? If you are able to access the internet via computer or smartphone, current information about Langley schools can be accessed on all school websites or <a href="www.sd35.bc.ca">www.sd35.bc.ca</a>. Updates are also posted to X (formerly Twitter) @LangleySchools and Facebook at <a href="www.facebook.com/langleyschooldistrict">www.facebook.com/langleyschooldistrict</a>. If you don't have internet connectivity but your phone is working, call a relative or friend in an area that has not been affected by the storm and ask them to check the district website for you. Local radio stations are also informed of school status in Langley. Tune in to CKWX 1130AM, CKNW 980AM, Country Radio 107.1FM, Pulse 107.7 or CBC 690AM or 88.1FM for updates.

Please note that Langley District schools are all considered 'open' until a decision to close is required. Decisions on school closures are usually made by 6:30am. As always, it is a parent's decision whether to send their child to school based on safety and individual circumstances. If you feel it is unsafe for you or your child to travel to or attend an open school for any reason, please keep your child home and report an absence to the school.

#### DROP-OFF & PICK-UP

The front entrance of the school parking lot is very busy during drop-off and pick-up times as we have many students who are bussed to school. Please do not drop off or pick-up your children directly out front of the school as it causes challenges when busses arrive to unload or pick-up. We appreciate your cooperation in minimizing the traffic at the front of our school.
